

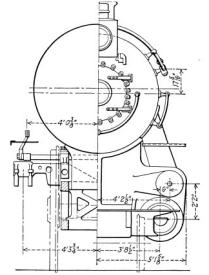


FROM THE HEAD END - Steve Staffieri, President

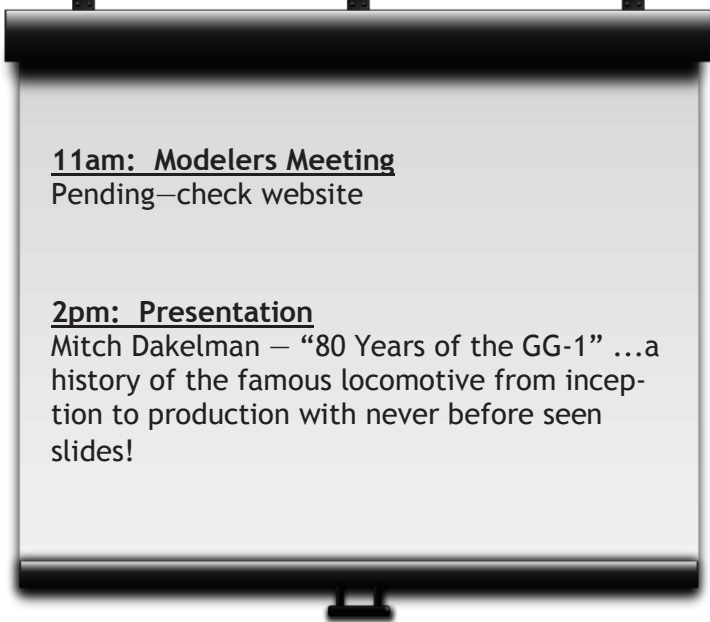

PHILADELPHIA CHAPTER OCTOBER MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

- Chapter member Paul Buckley is taking over the modeling committee. Anyone willing to give a presentation should contact Paul.
- Fred Monsimer presented at the Modelers Meeting, giving an update on progress being made by the GATSME Model Railroad Club (www.gatsme.org).
- Gus Minardi reported that the meetings entertainment would feature a presentation by Greg Pritchard, on the subject of "Pennsy Stations along the Philadelphia Main Line."
- Andy Hart reported National membership renewals at 90% and that the dues remain the same as they had been for the last 10 years, at \$35.
- Dave Scott reported the national web site had been taken down by a computer virus and was in the process of being restored.
- Member Sheila Dorr reported excursion news about the Colebrookdale Railroad. Running between Pottstown and Boyertown on a Reading branch, using a PRR locomotive and cabin car. More information at www.colebrookdalerailroad.com.
- Vice President Gus Minardi reminded attendees that he was not running for re-election, having soon completed 4-years at the vice president position. Other officers had indicated that they would be willing to continue. On a motion made by Steve Moylan, seconded by Al Giannantonio, Russ Polo was nominated for Vice President. Steve, Tom, Fred and Ken were nominated for re-election, and nominations were closed. Elections will take place at the December 6, 2014 meeting.

RED ARROW PHILADELPHIA SUBURBAN TRANSIT TROLLEY

The Newtown Square PA Railroad Museum Association have received, for free, a 1949 Red Arrow Philadelphia Suburban Transit (PST) Trolley. The trolley is currently located in Connecticut and could be moved to the Newtown Square PA Railroad Museum at a cost of \$5,000.
