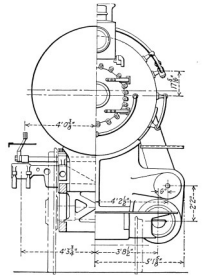




FROM THE HEAD END - Steve Staffieri, President

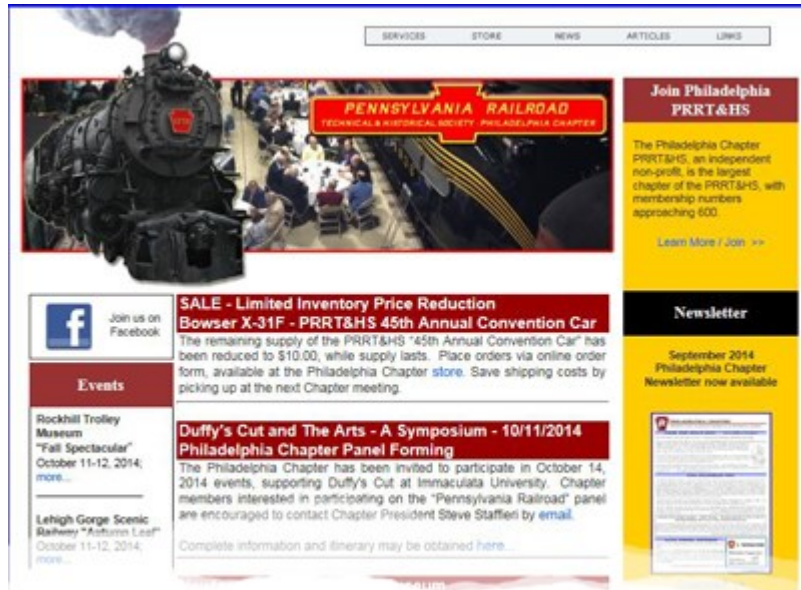
